In an effort to learn more about the archaeology of the Athabasca region, a research team began visiting and photographing private artifact collections of farmers from Barrhead to Lac La Biche in 2014. This presentation will discuss some of the exciting finds and provide short demonstrations about prehistoric life in Alberta.
