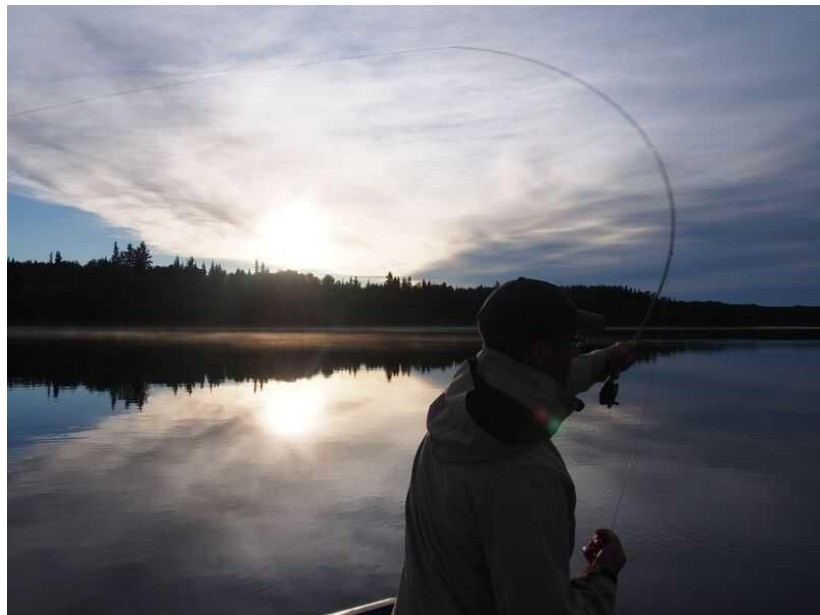

The Athabasca watershed accounts for 23% of the land area in Alberta and flows nearly 1400 km from its glacial headwaters in Jasper to the cool water Peace-Athabasca delta near the Western end of Lake Athabasca. In order to successfully manage such a large and diverse watershed and ensure long term sustainable and resilient fisheries, fisheries managers must incorporate social and ecological factors at a watershed scale. This talk will describe the diversity of fish life in the Athabasca watershed, detail the challenges of managing fisheries in Alberta and describe the solutions to promote sustainable and resilient fish populations.
