Learn how to identify and avoid dangerous and poisonous mushrooms while noting which wild mushrooms are safe and edible. We will also do a cooking demonstration (only with edible mushrooms!).**



We will meet at 11 AM at the chalet next to Landing Trail School for a 2-hour walk and start cooking small dishes at about 12:30. You may also bring your own mushrooms for identification. If you prefer not to walk, just wait for the mushroom hunters to return. Families with kids are encouraged to attend. Bring appropriate footwear and be prepared for adverse weather if you want to participate in the walk.
