Bob Hayes will explore how high wolf predation rates maintain Yukon moose at low density and why natural predation reduces the sustainable hunting opportunities for people. His original research shows wolves prefer to kill young and old animals, kill rate differs by wolf pack size, and small packs kill proportionally more moose because of scavenging by ravens.
