The forests and fields around Athabasca are abundant in plants and fungi with healing properties. Robert Rogers has studied plant medicines of the region for over 40 years and will share some of the edible, medicinal and survival aspects of nature. The walks are informative, humorous and insightful. He teaches plant and mushroom medicine at Grant MacEwan University and Northern Star College, and is an assistant clinical professor in family medicine at the University of Alberta. Robert is a professional member of the American Herbalist Guild, chair of medicinal mushroom committee of the North American Mycological Association and on the editorial board of the International Journal of Medicinal Mushrooms. He has authored 14 books on plants of the boreal forest as well as herb-drug interactions. His latest book, released in November 2011 is *The Fungal Pharmacy: the Complete Guide to Medicinal Mushrooms and Lichens of North America*. He will sign copies for those interested at end of walk.
